

WINTER RULES

Until further notice, the following local rules will apply:

PREFERRED LIES

A ball lying on a closely mown area through the green (the fairway) may, without penalty, be moved or lifted, cleaned and placed within six inches of where it originally lay, but not nearer the hole. The ball must be marked before being lifted or moved. A player may move or place his/her ball once and after the ball has been so moved or placed it is in play.

Penalty for breach of local rule:

Match Play - loss of hole Stroke Play - 2 strokes

EMBEDDED BALL THROUGH THE GREEN

Through the green, a ball which is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground, other than sand, may, without penalty, be lifted, cleaned and dropped, as near as possible to where it lay, but not nearer the hole. The ball must be marked before lifting and, when dropped, must first strike a part of the course through the green.

Exception: A player may not obtain relief under this local rule if it is clearly unreasonable for him/her to play a stroke because of interference by anything other than the condition covered by this local rule.

Penalty for breach of local rule:

Match Play - loss of hole Stroke Play - 2 strokes
